MADE IN THE MITTEN

Made in the Mitten is an homage to where it all began - on a skinny piece of wood in the backyards of the Midwest.

DAY 1

Five years after breaking his back in a snowboarding accident and being left paralyzed from the waist down, Trevor Kennison returns to the backcountry facing a new set of challenges. This first day out helps Trevor to redefine his perspective on the limitations of his injury, and what he's truly capable of.

THE CARELESS SKI TROOPER

From 1941 to 1943, the U.S. War Department created 7 detailed instructional films about... skiing. The films were important tools: thousands of American soldiers learned to ski during World War II as part of new "mountain" divisions. The movies were a fast way to introduce the rare sport and teach good habits.

STANDING TALL

Kirstie Ennis is a combat injured Marine amputee. While serving in the Marine Corps as a helicopter door gunner on her second deployment to Afghanistan, her helicopter went down. As a result of all of her injuries, she was medically retired. She joined the Marine Corps to serve others, now she can say she truly lives her life for others. Since 2017, Kirstie committed to her climbing for a cause initiative - climbing the highest peak on each of the seven continents and snowboarding some of them for charity.

THE WINTER

540 MILES

In pursuit of his bucket list aspirations, a retired 64 year old sets out to face the elements and traverse the entire Colorado Trail on his mountain bike.

HEADWINDS

The tiny Colorado mountain town of Ouray is a summertime recreation hotspot—normally. In Headwinds, Fat Tire examines the pandemic's impact on Ouray through the stories of its locals, seeking to understand how they've adapted to radical changes in our world.

THE ART OF RESCUE

The Alpine Rescue Team is a volunteer based non-profit whose mission is to help people who have become lost or injured while exploring the Colorado backcountry. This short documentary showcases what it's like to be part of this amazing group of people and illustrates how valuable they are to anyone who has found themselves in a less than ideal situation while enjoying the beauty of what Colorado has to offer.

CACHE LA POUFRE

This short-form documentary was made in celebration of the Cache La Poudre River in Fort Collins on its anniversary of being designated a "Wild & Scenic River," the only such river in the State of Colorado. We explored a brief history of the river, how important it is to the City of Fort Collins and its residents, as well as the issues we face in preserving it today.

GRATEFUL

Montana based adventure photographer Isaac Johnston has lived an unconventional life. Growing up in rural Montana, "thrashing" in his professional endeavors in his 20s and now settling into the life of a travel and lifestyle photographer are just a few examples. It's taken years for Isaac to discover what his path is but he's finally discovered what it is that sets his work apart.

THE FUNNY RUNNER

After quitting her job to pursue her dream of running professionally, Brittany Charboneau quickly found herself not having any fun with the sport she loved. A tough debut at the New York City Marathon and the following training left Brittany broken physically, mentally, and emotionally. Was there really only one path to success in becoming a professional runner or could Brittany throw away everything and do things her own way? This is a documentary film about the path Brittany Charboneau has pursued and what she has discovered about running and herself in the process.

HIGH COUNTRY

Entrenched in nostalgia, HIGH COUNTRY is a timeless story about a community of young people, disguised as hippies and ski bums, who happened upon a ramshackle immigrant mining town on the fringe of society and together fought to conserve and protect it for years to come. Our film will explore how one small mountain community has attempted to walk the line between development and conservation; growth and sustainability. This struggle, however, is not specific to Crested Butte, Colorado, it is a constant challenge for small towns across North America. In making this film, we are attempting to do our part, not only to conserve a piece of American history, but also to educate and inform future generations to come.

RODENTS OF UNUSUAL SIZE

The residents of Louisiana never know what will attack them next: floods, hurricanes, even monstrous swamp rats. Gigantic orange-toothed nutria are eating up the coastal wetlands, destroying the landscape, and threatening the very existence of the human population. This invasive South American species breeds faster than the roving squads of hunters and trappers can control them. But the people who have lived here for generations are not the type of folks who let their land—and their livelihoods—recede into the Gulf without a fight. Meet fisherman turned bounty hunter Thomas Gonzales and a pack of colorful diehards as they defend their land, culture, and way of life against the unforgiving forces of nature. It is man vs. rodent. May the best mammal win.

LAST CALL FOR TOMORROW

We are witnessing the 6th Mass Extinction of our planet. We are losing about 200 species a day. Humanity has killed 83% of all wild mammals and half of all plants. Of the birds left in the world, 70% are poultry chickens and other farmed birds. Global industrial pollution is killing over 9 million people a year, through bad air and water. What recourse can the people take, when there are no effective institutions to deal with the global one world order

GHOST TOWN

The last living residents of a ghost town lost to the New Mexican desert return to say their final farewells.

20 TO 20

This documentary tracks the experiences of four women through the generations of their family, in which the women live particularly long, starting in 1920 through to the generations growing up today. It showcases their experiences across the last century as well as the changing role of women in American society through a combination of interview and archival material, ranging from still photography from the early 1900's, to digital video. The film concludes with the 100th birthday celebration of the eldest subject which coincidentally coincides with the 100th anniversary of a monumental milestone in women's rights: the ratification of the 19th amendment.

WOMEN OF THE EARTH

Two sisters in the Hudson Valley draw on their familial farming practices, using hemp to heal soil while blazing a trail in regenerative agriculture.

SOCIAL FABRIC

This documentary is a chance to share the inspiring story of how local businesses here in Moabit, where we live, are finding new ways to support the locals that live here. Throughout this process we have discovered that local businesses here in Moabit serve more than just food or fix bikes or provide services - rather, they play an integral role in the social fabric of our neighborhood.

THE ART OF DISSENT

"The Art of Dissent" celebrates the resilience and power of artistic engagement in Czechoslovakia before and after the 1968 Soviet-led invasion. The documentary's main protagonists – Václav Havel, banned singer Marta Kubišová, and the underground rock group the Plastic People of the Universe (PPU) – became the most recognizable dissidents during the 1970-80s. Havel bridged the disparate clusters of individuals and fused the literary, musical, political, and philosophical nonviolent elements into a hybrid network that eventually toppled the totalitarian regime in 1989.

THOUGHTS AND PRAYERS

Thoughts and Prayers explores how people remember the day of the Columbine shooting and how they navigated media coverage of the event, from both sides of the camera. Set against the lead-up to the event's 20th anniversary, the film follows journalists and survivors as they reflect on the past two decades and strive to spread a message of hope

TUSCALOOSA

1972. Vietnam war protests and racial tension is sizzling in the late summer heat of Tuscaloosa, Alabama. Billy Mitchell (Devon Bostick, Diary of a Wimpy Kid), a recent college graduate, spends the summer working on the lush grounds of an old world mental institution run by his psychiatrist father (Tate Donovan, Rocketman). Billy falls in love with Virginia (Natalia Dyer, Velvet Buzzsaw, Stranger Things), a patient who is possibly crazy, or perhaps she is the only sane person Billy has in his world. Billy's best friend Nigel (Marchánt Davis) becomes involved with a radical civil rights activist (YG) against Tuscaloosa's power elite, which includes Billy's father. Billy is torn between Nigel, his father and his cronies, and Virginia who is planning her escape with or without Billy.

KOSELIG

A sleepless documentary crew follows Alecko Tufte, a Slow TV creator based in America, as he sets out on this record-breaking quest. With 134+ hours to burn, Alecko spends his time between shooting introducing his beloved craft to American audiences and talking to the crew about his trials, roots, and inspirations. The grueling hours begin to wear at the crew, but Alecko's enthusiasm is unwavering. It is not his will that is questioned but that of the crew as they begin to realize neither party may have been as clear about their intentions with the documentary as they each originally thought.

BUZZ VS SCOOTY

Men will be boys. Two grown men argue about whose dad is tougher. They arrange for their elderly fathers to meet in the ring for a testosterone filled, epic battle.

EGG PARTY

Six women in their late-thirties gather, with lots of wine and laughter, to dye Easter eggs. Through a series of whimsical portraits we discover each woman's view on her respective egg, lost dreams, and new beginnings. As the afternoon light shifts around them, it is revealed they have gathered to support their friend Molly, who is desperate for motherhood and struggling through loss and infertility. After her world is cracked open, coming together becomes the greatest balm to heal a grieving spirit.

An astronomer sharing online backyard observations of the center of our galaxy has a run-in with mosquitoes, and a not so trusty bug zapper.

TREE HUGGERS

Tree Huggers is a buddy copy comedy between man and nature, celebrating the wonder of the great outdoors.

EXIT PACKAGE

A black comedy, quarantine era murder mystery - a ZOOM meeting for a corrupt investment company goes horribly wrong. Made completely through ZOOM, with all of the actors working from home.

THE HERMIT

In the 1950's cats began disappearing in Sandpoint, Idaho. A hermit was accused and quickly taken to the asylum, never to be heard from again...until now. Rumor has it that he's escaped. Three brave young men set out in the Selkirk Mountains to find him.

COLD BLOODED

Two criminals, in desperate need of a second chance, cross paths in a way that will change their fate permanently.

REBEL

When she finds herself alone on a stranded planet, a young rebel must gather the strength to survive while being hunted by a Sith Lord. Rebel is a women-led Star Wars-inspired student fan film.

PORTRAIT OF PEARL

After learning of her estranged Fathers passing, Pearl must decide to pick up the pieces left by the man who abandoned her, or to leave her many questions unanswered.

STATES OF CONTENTION

After becoming separated from her elite unit a determined soldier grapples with shifting loyalties and a shadowy adversary to fight for what, and who, is truly important. Yet it all seems strangely familiar...

FOULHOOK

A typical morning fishing trip turns into a foot chase through the woods as a father desperately tries to save his daughter, her future, and his own sanity.

MAGGIE

A short film showing one woman's struggle to escape a life of sex work.

ISOLATION

Set in a world running parallel to our own pandemic-gripped reality, ISOLATION dips into the life of John (Alexander Johnson), a young man sequestered in his high-rise apartment, waiting in tandem with a paused outside world swept up in illness. Even locked doors in the sky can be knocked upon, however, and when his past comes knocking, his isolation is rocked.

ONCE UPON A PANDEMIC

"Once Upon a Pandemic" is the story of a young girl Maddie, self-isolated in her home during a global pandemic without help from her quarantined Mom. With the help of her Dad, Maddie uses her strength and resilience to overcome a heartbreaking twist as only a child can.

SAVING AMELIA

When two contentious sisters stumble upon an old two-way radio as they explore their attic while stuck at home, they realize it can mysteriously communicate with the past. As they start playing with the radio, they realize they are speaking with Amelia Earhart moments before the final transmission of her ill-fated flight.
